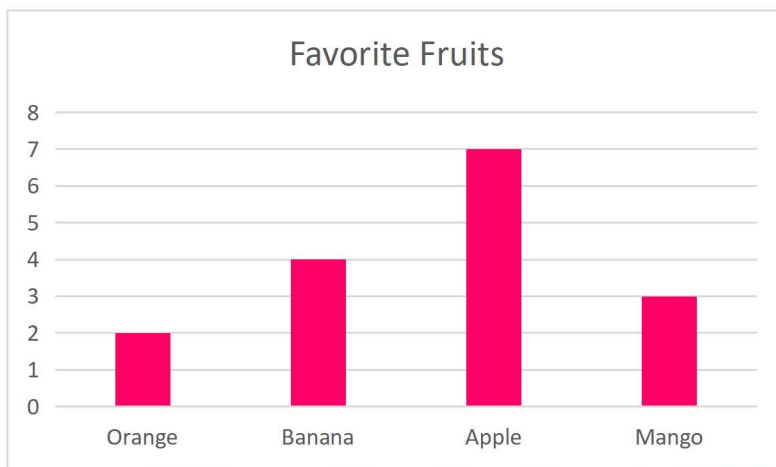

Answer Key:

Q.1. b) Orange and Apple

According to the graph - Number of children whose favorite fruit is -

Orange - 2

Banana - 4

Apple - 7

Mango - 3

So the least favourite fruit is Orange and the most favourite fruit is Apple.

Q.2. c) 437

We compare the digit at the hundreds place in all the numbers to find the largest number. The digits at the hundreds place for all the numbers are- 3, 1, 4 and 3. So the largest number will be 437 as number 4 is the largest digit.

Q.3. a) trouble

The correct spelling is 'trouble'.

Q.4. b) loaves

The plural of loaf is loaves.

The word 'loaf' follows the rule of changing the last letter 'f' with 'ves' to form its plural.

Q.5. b) So that they can hear the cat coming.

The mice wanted to bell the cat so that they can hear the cat coming and thereby they can save themselves from the cat by hiding away.

Q.6. b) A bell

The big grey mouse wanted to hang a bell on the cat's neck.

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
