Shyla and Tanya are each reading a novel. Shyla read 40 pages in the last five days and Tanya read 120 pages in the last 24 days. What is the difference between their unit rates per day?

- A) 3 pages per day
- B) 5 pages per day
- C) 8 pages per day
- D) 13 pages per day

Question 2: Math

How many feet are in 84 inches?

- a) 5 feet
- b) 6 feet

- d) 8 feet

Question 3: Language Usage

Question 5: Reading

Read the passage and answer the question.

"Many animals have adapted to their environments in fascinating ways. For example, the Arctic fox has developed thick fur to keep warm in icy conditions, while camels have evolved to store water and survive in the desert. These adaptations help animals live comfortably in their specific habitats."

What is the main idea of the following passage?

- A) Animals have developed different ways to live in the Arctic.
- B) The Arctic fox and camels are examples of animals adapted to their environments.
- C) Animals only adapt to very cold environments.
- D) Camels are the only animals that can live in the desert.



Question 6: Reading

Read the passage and answer the question.

Have you ever heard someone sing, "Happy birthday to you . . . happy birthday to you"? If so, you are hardly alone—millions of people sing that song every year, and the tune is one of the most familiar of any song in North America. Ironically, it is not known who wrote it! The tune was written by two sisters, Patty and Mildred Hill, who were school teachers in the late 19th century. But their song had different words; instead of "happy birthday to you," the song ran "good morning to all." The two sisters would sing this ditty to their students each morning as school began. In 1924, the tune was published in a song book, which added the "happy birthday" lyrics as verse two. Today, the second verse of that song has become one of the best known tunes in the world—and nobody knows who wrote the words!

According to the passage, which of the following statements is true?

- a) Patty and Mildred Hill wrote the "Happy Birthday" lyrics and melody.
- b) The "Happy Birthday" lyrics were added to the original tune in 1924.
- c) The original lyrics of the song were "Happy Birthday to you."
- d) The melody of the song was first published by Patty and Mildred Hill in 1924.



Answer Key:

Q1. a) 3 pages per day

A unit rate, means the number of pages read in one day, as unit means one.

Shyla reads 40 pages in 5 days.

To calculate her unit rate per day, we divide the total pages by the number of

days: $40 \div 5 = 8$ pages per day.

For Tanya: $120 \div 24 = 5$ pages per day.

The difference means subtract the unit rates, therefore: 8 - 5 = 3 pages per day.

Q2. c) 7 feet



Q3. a) My grandfather's car was not working on Tuesday.

In English Language, the sentence must start with a capital letter word and end in a full stop.

The word 'tuesday' is a proper noun and must be written as 'Tuesday'.

The word 'grandfathers' is actually a word with an apostrophe 's' that shows the **relation of the car to the grandfather**.

Thus, the word must be written as "grandfather's".

Therefore, the given sentence is written as:

My grandfather's car was not working on Tuesday.



Q4. b) I had seen the movie.

The past perfect tense is used to express something that happened before something else.

The sentence 'I saw a movie', can be converted into past perfect tense by using the words 'had seen'.

Q5. b) The Arctic fox and camels are examples of animals adapted to their environments.

The passage focuses on how different animals have evolved adaptations to survive in their specific environments. Option B correctly summarizes this main idea by mentioning the Arctic fox and camels as examples of these adaptations.

Q6. b) The "Happy Birthday" lyrics were added to the original tune in 1924.

The passage explains that Patty and Mildred Hill originally wrote a song with the lyrics "Good morning to all," not "Happy Birthday to you." The "Happy Birthday" lyrics were added to the tune in 1924, which means that the tune itself was published earlier but with different lyrics. Option B correctly identifies this fact, making it the correct answer.
